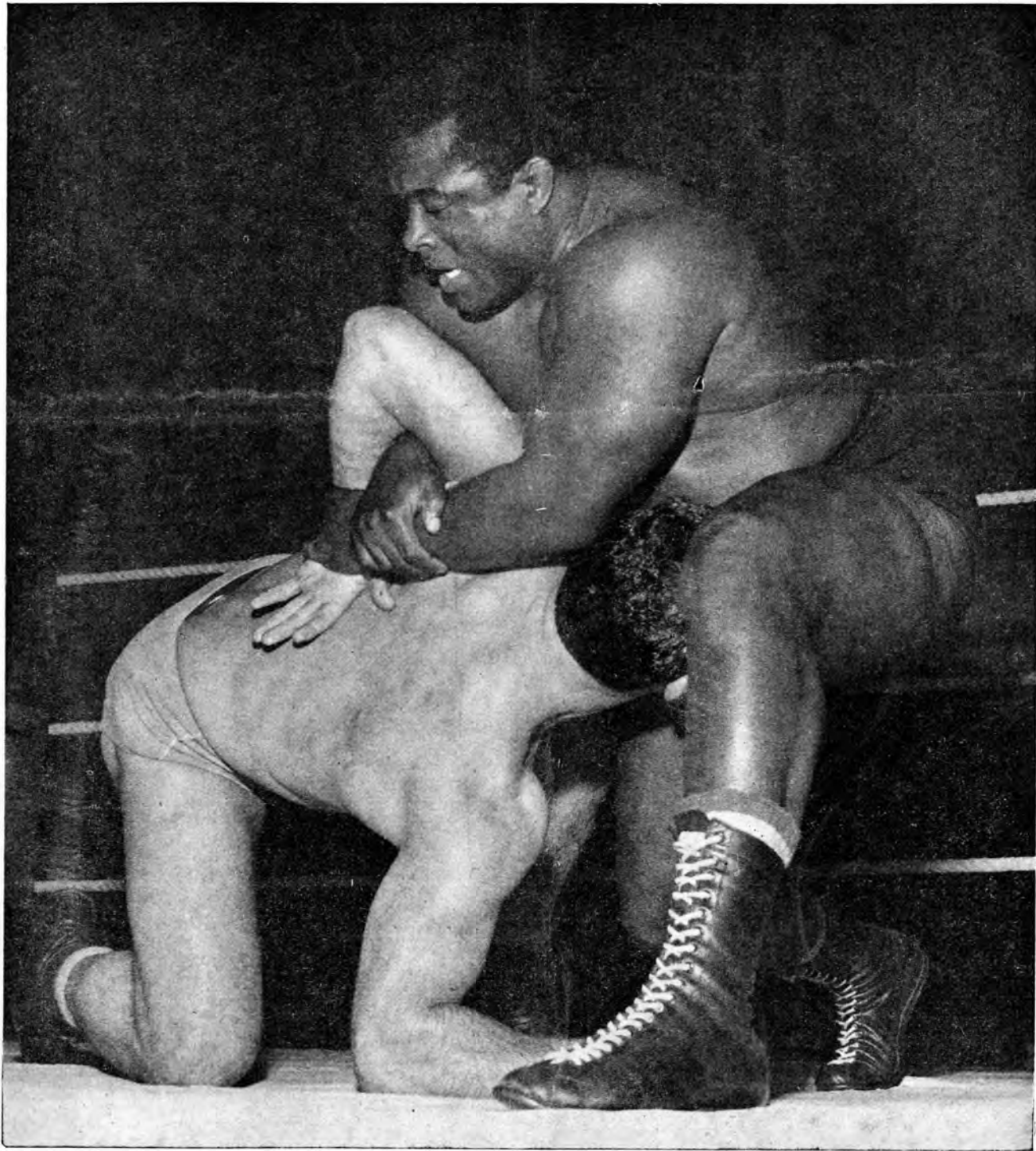

Spotlight on a Star

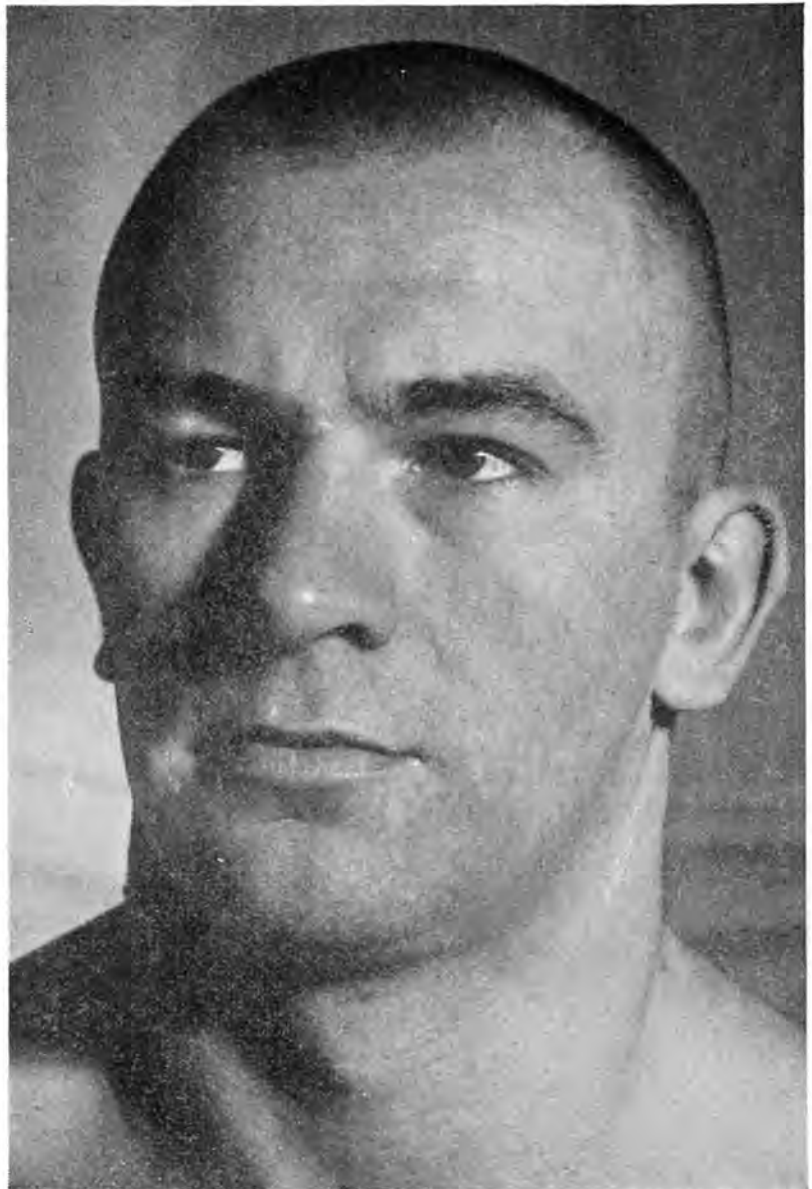
Ivan Josef ZARANOFF of U.S.S.R.

Russian athletes have always been prominent in the field of sporting endeavour and heavy-weight wrestler Ivan Josef Zaranoff, who was born near Leningrad, is one who has found his fame and glory in between the four ropes, a square they call a "ring".

The general conception of the Russian strongman is that he is a giant with bulging muscles, but Josef Zaranoff—or just plain "Jo" to his circle of friends—is not. He is, in fact, a smooth, lithe athlete who moves about the ring with the ease of a panther.

Brilliant in wrestling "know-how", Zaranoff has been described as one of the best tactical wrestlers to turn professional since the war.

He may have made his name in our rings, but "Jo" has been to many places in the world. He has both boxed and wrestled in the United States and Canada where



he first went after fleeing from Russia.

Ever since the days when the "Russian Lion", George Hackenschmidt, contested for the first heavyweight championship of the world, Russian wrestlers have sought this prize. Maybe one of these days Ivan Josef Zaranoff, the modern-day challenger, will get his chance.

"Cowboy" Bob Ellis, the popular young heavyweight from San Angelo, Texas, is currently on a world tour, he may come here. He has been a professional wrestler since 1955 when the great Ed "Strangler" Lewis, five times heavyweight champion of the world, led him into the professional ring.
